Mission Statement:

Bay Ridge Preparatory School is dedicated to enriching intellectual curiosity, creativity, and emotional intelligence through an inclusive, student-centered community that values the talents and interests of each person.

The School and Community:

Bay Ridge Prep is an independent, non-profit, co-educational, college-preparatory K-12 school located in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn. The school has two primary facilities, one housing our Lower/ Middle schools, and the other our four-year Upper School. Bay Ridge Prep opened in the fall of 1998 and graduated its first senior class in spring 1999. The Upper School now enrolls approximately 180 students in grades 9-12, serving all five boroughs of New York City and Long Island. Approximately 30% of our students identify as students of color.

The Upper School allows students to realize the academic rigor that will be experienced in an undergraduate program while still learning in an environment that promotes creativity and celebrates each individual. A faculty composed of highly qualified and engaging teachers are committed to Bay Ridge Prep's mission of valuing the unique talents and learning styles of each student. We explicitly teach skills that build emotional and social intelligence, which help students create healthy and satisfying relationships in and outside of school. We provide students the freedom and responsibility to pursue their interests through open-ended

projects, a wide course selection and a variety of student-initiated clubs.

We emphasize innovation, creativity and practical application over acquiring rote knowledge that can be easily accessed on any digital device.

Curriculum: A Tailored Academic Experience

Bay Ridge Prep offers a challenging curriculum that includes opportunities for advanced learning, research, exploration and discovering new passions.

Bay Ridge Prep offers a wide variety of elective courses, both per semester and full-year. Students at all levels can select from electives in Physical Education and the Arts, and students at the upper levels can additionally select from electives in Science, Psychology, Economics, History, Languages, and Computer Science. We offer a full array of arts programs including music, dance, graphic design, jazz ensemble, photography, theater and studio art.

All Bay Ridge Prep Upper School students are encouraged to be involved in community service. Opportunities are provided through our Community Service club, as well as through the National Honor Society, of which our school is a member organization. Seniors are required to perform a senior project. They are given Fridays off from school, once per week during the second semester, to engage in activities related to their project, whether it be research,

community service, or internship experience. Students can select their own projects/ sites (subject to approval), or are assisted in developing their project through a faculty mentor.

In addition to our mainstream program, two supportive programs are available for students with specific learning differences. The Achieve and Bridge Programs exist within our mainstream learning environment and develop students' study skills, organization, reading and writing. Modified Courses are for students in our Bridge Program who have significant learning disabilities. Modifications include slower pacing of material and access to approved accommodations for testing and learning, and courses providing curricular modifications are denoted as Modified on the transcript. Most modified courses mirror their mainstream counterparts in terms of major content covered.
